Covid-19

In accordance with the Order of the Galician Health Council, October 26th 2021:

In the official hostels of the public network of the Xunta de Galicia shared occupation of the available beds can extend to 100%, providing that all those of 12 years of age and above are in possession of a certificate issued by the Public Health Service or, in the case referred to in 2o, by an officially authorized laboratory, which declares its compliance with any of the following circumstances:

1o. That the person concerned has received the complete dose of an anti-Covid-19 vaccine for which commercial authorization was granted in conformity with the Regulation (CE) N° 726/2004.

2o. That they are in possession of a negative diagnostic text, carried out in the last 72 hours (in the case of a PCR or the past 48 hours in the case of an antigen test. In the case of rapid antigen tests, they should figure in the general and up-to-date list of rapid antigen test COVID-19 created according to Recommendation 2021/C24/01 of the European Council.

3o. That the person in question recovered from a SARS-CoV-2 infection over the last 6 months. To demonstrate this, the person involved will need to have been diagnosed as a confirmed case of COVID-19 11 days before, or more by means of a PCR, no other type of test is acceptable.

It will not be necessary to provide any sort of documentation when staying in the hostel if the occupation of the shared accommodation does not exceed 50% of the available space. The same is true when all the occupants are doing the St James's Way in all of its component stages here in Galicia as members of a "bubble group" group, or who habitually live together.
